



Top Tips for Revision in Geography

- Read the question carefully
- BUG: Box the command word, Underline key terms, Glance back at the question
- Use the green revision guide and your class books to revise content
- Use the summary case study sheet to revise case studies
- Make sure you pick the correct case study to answer the question.

Key Revision Techniques

- Make mind maps/flash cards of the case studies/key terms
- Complete the OCR B Geography course on Seneca
- Complete the forms homework which is based on past questions
- Revise in short chunks of 20-30 minutes.
- For top grades access the OCR B Geography GCSE website to complete past papers and check mark schemes
- Even if you are not sure on a question NEVER leave it blank- bullet point what you know.
- Test yourself by recalling knowledge from memory- for example give 5 facts about the Dhaka case study.

Revision Sessions

- The best way for you to revise is to complete your weekly revision homework and to come motivated and focused to lessons.
- If you need specific help speak to your teacher and we will make time to help you at a break time, after school or during tutor time.
