



Top Tips for Revision in

- Link the theory in Health and Social care to real contexts and health scenarios.
- Focus on the COMMAND word for the questions and produce evidence to show your knowledge
- Relevance – make sure the evidence in your answer answers the question and is not a scattering of a range of facts which you hope are relevant.

Key Revision Techniques

- Use the quizzes and revision powerpoints to help you build your working knowledge of Health and Social Care theory.
- The revision book for J835 is colour coded to help you learn 'chunks' of information on the four topic areas of the RO32 exam
 - Topic Area 1 = The RIGHTS of service users in health and social care settings
 - Topic Area 2 = Person-centred values
 - Topic Area 3 = Effective communication skills in health and social care settings
 - Topic Area 4 = Protecting service users and service providers in health and social care settings.
