



Top Tips for Revision in History

- You should be using the booklets and folders that we use in lessons as a basis for your revision.
- For History Around Us (Exeter Cathedral) there is no need to look anywhere other than your booklets, they contain everything you need and everything that the exam board have been told.
- Good revision requires you to not just consider what happened, but also when, why and the impact that it had.
- As well as content, it is important that you practice exam questions as well. These can be found in your booklets but also the OCR website where you can access the back catalogue of previous exam questions.

Key Revision Techniques

The booklets can be used to re-do exam questions or produce revision resources such as:

- Flash cards
- mind-maps (Once one has been completed, you should re-produce it but with reduced words, then re-produced again with even less words BEFORE seeing if you can add the level of detail that was on the first version.)
- Creative storyboards.
- producing own quizzes.
- Timelines are also worth creating, these will help you with the chronology of events and how they're linked together. It would be worth also colour – coding your timelines so that you can see other factors
