Behaviour Update

Pupils continue to receive positive points each lesson for demonstrating an OKE 8 character habit either within their work or

themselves. The introduction of the rewards exchange shop now enables pupils to spend their achievement points on items in the canteen or raffle tickets to give them a greater chance of winning a bigger prize at the end of each term. Pupils have already received 25973 points collectively since half term and spent 10220 points on items such as these below.

Dartmoor Trust Careers Fair

We were delighted to hold the first DMAT Careers Fair which took place at Ashbury Hotel this week. This was attended by students in Year 9 and 10 on Wednesday with students in Years 11, 12 and 13 attending on Thursday.

As it was a MAT wide event, with students attending from Okehampton, Tavistock and Holsworthy Colleges, it meant we were able to attract a large number of employers, apprenticeship providers, Further Education providers and universities. This gave the students a wide range of exhibitors to visit; alongside presentations from key speakers.

Students conducted themselves well and really engaged positively in the process of speaking to exhibitors and asking questions about their organisations and job sectors. They enjoyed many interactive items on the stands such as a virtual reality headset (to view a real-life engineering construction site) not to mention the chance to grab leaflets and the odd free pen!!

It really was an amazing opportunity for our students to think about and gather information about their future career plans from a range of experts. It really helped to bring their careers education to life and was a great way to mark National Careers Week.

Year 10 Information Evening

On Wednesday evening we welcomed Year 10 pupils with their parents to our Year 10 Exam Preparation event. With a near capacity Octagon theatre, the focus of the evening was to share our plans to support the preparation for the upcoming Year 10 exams, which begin after the Easter break.

Mrs Carter and Miss Hawkins, Head of Mathematics and Head of English respectively, gave important insights of how to prepare for their specific subjects. Mr White, Assistant Principal, shared revision preparation tips whilst Mrs Hodgson the Head of Year 10, shared the holistic approach to exam preparation and wellbeing during the exams. Miss Simpson, Examinations Officer gave parents and pupils exam guidance booklets together with sharing the Year 10 exam timetable for pupils to begin their preparation for the exams.
