Geography Field Trip

On Monday 13th March and Tuesday 14th March a total of 137 Year 11 geographers split over two days visited Dawlish Warren to collect data on the physical processes affecting the coastline and the reasons for the different coastal management strategies.

On the Monday we endured the wind whereas on Tuesday the sun came out which meant for data collection in the sun! Students stood underneath the Langstone rock sea-arch to observe the physical processes that have shaped this feature and later looked at how groynes are stopping the process of long-shore-drift. There were only a few wet feet and the odd booklet that had to be chased down the beach but overall, it was an invaluable experience to now use in GCSE exam questions.
