Through Empowerment students are activity taught how to safeguard themselves as part of the personal development curriculum. Through Prevention staff are trained to respond effectively to the needs of students. Through Proportionality actions are taken in response to the safeguarding risk as these risks are identified. Through Protection maintaining a safe college site and environment to learn. Through Partnership maintaining regular communications with external agencies to support in college and the wider community. Through Accountability every member of staff knows their duty of care and records concerns, so action is taken.


