"I liked the freedom and how calm it is"


"The activities were fun and the free food was good"

#### Sports Day 2023

On Tuesday 27th June 2023 Okehampton College took part in Sports Day. All pupils were involved from Years 7-11 whether participating in the athletics events or assisting with the results, running of the events, media and journalism teams and banner making.

We were also supported by an excellent group of 12 Year 12 students who did a Stirling job all day. Students in Years 9 and 10 carried out their competition during periods 1 and 2 and Students in Years 7 and 8 took part during periods 3 and 4. We then had whole college participation during period 5 for the relays, banner making competition and tug of war.

There was a fantastic atmosphere during period 5 in particular with students showing great support, camaraderie and sportsmanship of each other. It was a fantastic day for achievement with many records being broken in the athletics events including winners of the 300m in Years 7, 8, 9 and 10; 1500m runners in Years 7 and 10 and many of the javelin throws. The addition of the Tug of War event was very successful, and students (and tutors) got really competitive for glory, showing amazing teamwork and community.
