TASK TWO

Firstly.....

- PLEASE – make sure you are keeping up to date with any messages on the teams page. A lot of you are emailing the same questions that have already been answered on the page.
- Try and talk and message on teams rather than email, that way we can keep track of what has been said. We are getting lots of emails at the moment as you can imagine.
- We appreciate all your enthusiasm and are excited to see the personal investigation develop.

Just to clarify.....

- This is a very important MARKED part of your a-level.
- This is a completely new project to be completed in a new sketchbook.
- You should have left a gap for a title page and mind map
- You are very unlikely to have a title at the moment, we often save this till later as the project progresses more.
- As the project progresses it is fine for you to take out and use work from your previous year 12 work. We just ask that your main artist is a new one as there is more an element of anticipation and not knowing attached to a new artists.

Where should you be at?

- Completed and submitted your proposal forms.
- You should now Have completed a page anticipating your virtual trip to visit your chosen artists work.
- A detailed page on the artists work you visited virtually, analysing individual pieces of work.

We will now be giving you weekly tasks.

- You will need a double page in your sketchbook.
- This week you will need to create a response to the artists work that you visited. On a double page add an image of ONE piece of the artists work.
- Make yourself a view finder and find an interesting part of the work. Recreate this piece using the techniques and materials used by the artist. For textiles this will be a textile sample.
- Secondly pick a larger area and complete a copy of this.
