- Experiment with different length tubes and focal points. Document your settings and findings as usual.



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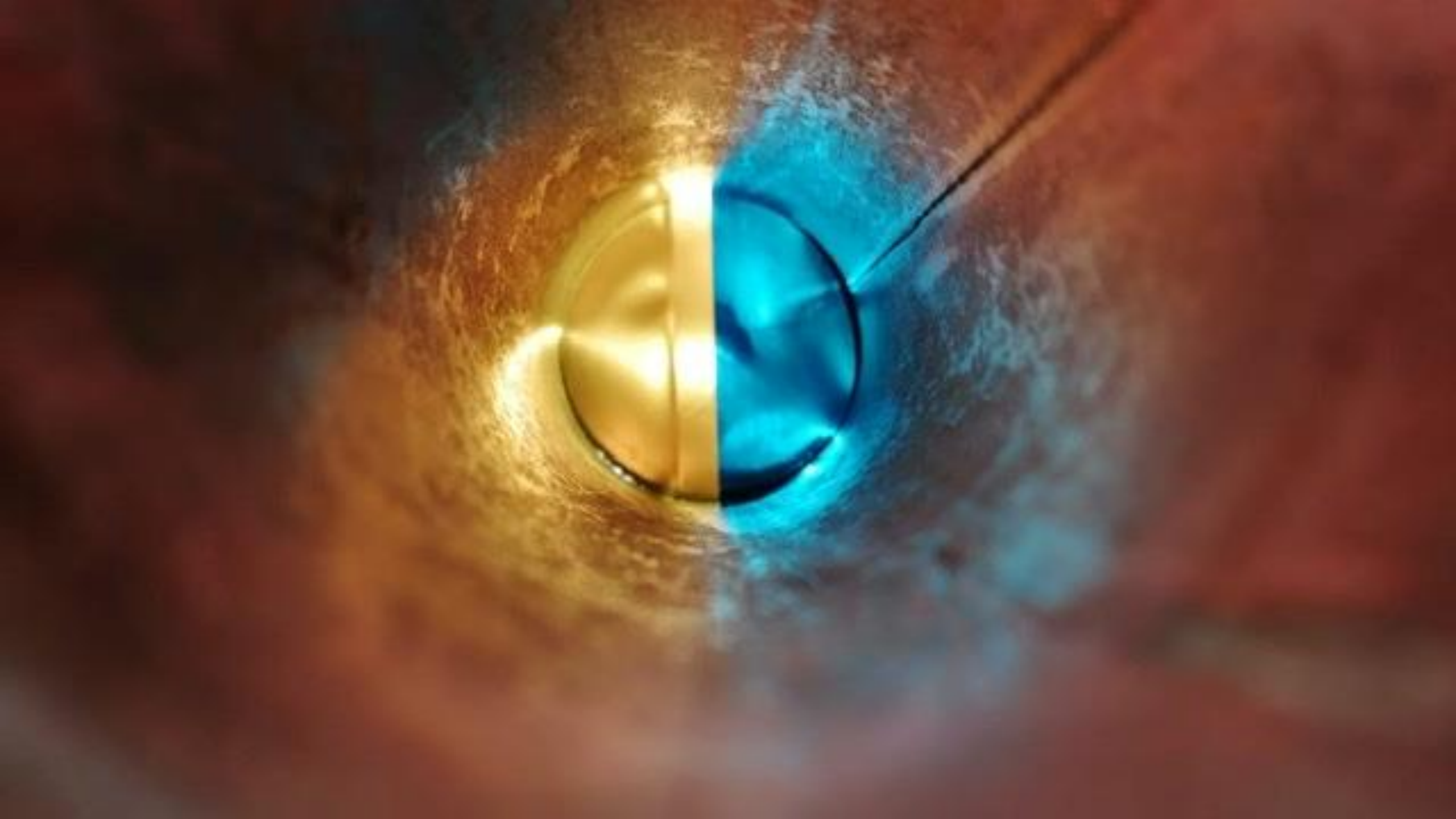
