

## Key Learning Areas for Year 7 Drama

Please note that the following is **NOT** extra work for students who have already completed all their online learning, although these students may wish to **revise** the Knowledge Organisers to prepare for the assessment in September.

As you will know, your child has been set a weekly Drama remote learning assignment since April. These assignments can still be accessed by clicking the 'Past' tab once logged into ClassCharts.

**We have identified 4 key learning areas from this remote learning that will be assessed in September:**

1. Peter Pan Week 1 **Physical Skills**  
(ClassCharts task set week beginning 13<sup>th</sup> April)
2. Peter Pan Week 3: **Lighting Design**  
(ClassCharts task set week beginning 27<sup>th</sup> April)
3. Peter Pan Week 4: **Costume Design**  
(ClassCharts task set week beginning 4<sup>th</sup> May)
4. Peter Pan Week 6: **Set Design**  
(ClassCharts task set week beginning 18<sup>th</sup> May)

**No Internet access is needed for the theatre evaluation assignments as an image has been provided for each topic, but students can watch extracts if they would like to do so and if they have Internet access** [Log in details are on the PowerPoint and the worksheet].
