

Key Learning Areas for Year 10 Drama

Please note that the following is **NOT** extra work for students who have already completed all their online learning, although these students may wish to **revise** the Knowledge Organisers to prepare for the assessment in September.

As you will know, your child has been set Drama remote learning assignments on ClassCharts (two per week). These assignments can still be accessed by clicking the 'Past' tab once logged into ClassCharts. To support this learning, your child has also been invited to access regular, twice-weekly online sessions on Microsoft Teams with their teacher since the start of Term 5. This work has been based on exam preparation, specifically the set text: 'An Inspector Calls' and Live Theatre Evaluation.

In order to ensure that all students are up to date and ready for Year 11 by September, we have identified 5 key learning areas from this remote learning that will be assessed in September:

1. 'An Inspector Calls': **Staging Design**
(ClassCharts assignment set week beginning 27th April)
2. 'An Inspector Calls': **Lighting Design**
(ClassCharts assignment set week beginning 11th May)
3. 'An Inspector Calls': **Costume Design**
(ClassCharts assignment set week beginning 1st June)
4. 'An Inspector Calls': **Sound Design**
(ClassCharts assignment set week beginning 8th June)
5. 'An Inspector Calls': **Set Design**
(ClassCharts assignment set week beginning 15th June)

We have created the '**Year 10 Drama Remote Learning Checklist**' below to support students in managing their remote learning. This sheet contains a breakdown of key tasks in each assignment on page 1 as well as links to useful online resources on page 2. This document is for:
